Thank you for your email and attached letter warning me that you have criticised some of my actions in your draft report.

It is entirely up to you if you wish to criticise me in your report; that is for you to judge. I explained to you and to others at length why I felt that I was justified in concluding that Cormac deliberately lied to the HSE on more than one occasion. There is no point in my reiterating those arguments to you now. However, what I would ask is that you name me in your report. I am not a bit-part actor in this matter. I have no wish to be anonymised. My role has been central in this whole affair. Without my intervention, the unfortunate injury suffered by Mr Richards would have remained a closely guarded secret within Corserv and you would not have been asked to conduct this investigation. Please include in your report my name and role, i.e. Cornwall Councillor for the Tregony area in which Mr Richards lives, although note that I am no longer the Cornwall Councillor since I did not stand in the recent elections.

You ask that I treat your letter as confidential. I do not consider that I have any duty of confidentiality in this matter. You have sent a draft report to Cornwall Council and Corsery and so they will have already seen your criticisms of me. I. of course, have not seen your draft report and so I don't know what you said about them. It is I, not Cornwall Council press office, that will decide when your criticisms of me come into the public domain. It is likely to be sooner rather than
