Executive Summary

During the afternoon of Friday 16th December 2016 the CORMAC Highway Safety Inspector for the Tregony area, Mr Andrew Richards, was found sitting alone in the crib room at the Grampound Road Depot, Grampound Road, Truro, Cornwall TR2 4TB.

Mr Richards had his head in his hands and was seen to be bleeding from the back of his head.

An Ambulance was called via the 999 system and, following initial assessment by a paramedic at the scene, Mr Richards was conveyed to Hospital.

Subsequent enquiries reveal he had a fractured skull and a bleed on the brain, although this was not evident at the time when he was found.

There were no witnesses to whatever incident had caused the injury and no obvious clues as to its cause.

Mr Richards was detained in hospital for two nights before being discharged. At the time of this report he has not recovered from the incident sufficiently to enable him to return to work.
